### Quito

## | Day Notes

Your journey begins with a hotel pick-up by your guide. Then, you'll set off to explore one of Latin America's most enchanting cities: Quito. Recognized as a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1978, Quito is captivated by its stunning colonial district and friendly inhabitants. You'll be taken to some of the city's most extraordinary locations.

Our first stop is The Basílica del Voto Nacional. It is a prominent Catholic church and a striking example of American neo-Gothic architecture. Construction began in 1892 and remains technically unfinished, following a local legend claiming that completing the basilica would signify the world's end. It is one of the most significant neo-Gothic structures in the New World, featuring intricate stained-glass windows, towering spires, and

grotesques inspired by Ecuadorian fauna. The basilica is a significant cultural landmark in Quito, offering panoramic city views from its towers.

Next, we'll visit the Independence Square, Plaza de La Independencia. This vibrant square is flanked by key governmental buildings—the Archbishop's Palace, the Presidential Palace, and the Cathedral—making it Ecuador's cultural epicenter.

Your next visit is, La Casa del Alabado. Nestled in Quito's Historic Center, this architectural gem is one of the city's most ancient buildings. Its construction presumably began in the late sixteenth century, though the exact date remains a mystery. Known as La Casa del Alabado since 1671, an inscription from this year is proudly displayed on a stone beam of the façade. Today, this house, graced by various architectural styles since the Colonial era, serves as a sanctuary of the nation's pre-Columbian heritage, where stories, eras, and locations harmoniously coexist.

We'll pause for lunch at a local restaurant before continuing our journey to the "Mitad del Mundo," or the Middle of the World. This monument commemorates the 18th-century French geodesic mission pinpointing where the equatorial line divides the northern and southern hemispheres. It's a unique opportunity to straddle both hemispheres simultaneously—perfect for a memorable selfie.

Our visit to Mitad del Mundo city includes a stop at the Intiñan Museum, where you'll delve into Ecuador's indigenous culture and partake in special experiments only possible at latitude 0°. The day concludes with a leisurely drive back to your hotel, rich with memories of a captivating day in Quito.

This unique ecosystem is renowned for its impressive variety of bird and plant species, making it a dream location for nature enthusiasts. Its proximity to Quito enhances its appeal, offering city dwellers an easily accessible escape into nature's embrace. In Mindo, you'll be captivated by the forest's beauty and have the chance to partake in various outdoor activities, making it an ideal retreat for families and those seeking harmony with nature.

Your journey begins early in the morning when our guide will collect you for the approximately 100 km (62 miles) trip to the charming town of Mindo.

Mindo has several rivers running through the cloud forest, with semi-rapid waters that allow tourists to embark on a buoy and be dragged for miles down the river while enjoying a fantastic adventure. Tubing is one of those adventure sports in which participants can enjoy intense emotions and adrenaline, play water games, and much more.

Afterward, you can enjoy canopy time, a tour of 10 different cables, using safety equipment, and in the company of our specialized guides, where you can enjoy the adventure and adrenaline that the sensation of flying between the mountains of the cloud forest of Mindo offers.

*Restrictions: The minimum age is six years, and the maximum weight is 140 kg. It is not allowed for pregnant women, people with heart problems, asthma, or hypertension.*

Nearby lies a serene creek, perfect for snorkeling adventures. Here, you can observe sea lions, sea turtles, rays, and a diverse range of fish in their natural habitat.

Tijeretas holds a special allure as it's one of the few places to witness Frigatebirds nesting. Seeing these magnificent birds in their natural setting is a spectacle that nature enthusiasts and birdwatchers will cherish.

We'll head to the serene Carola Beach to cap off our day. Here, we'll immerse ourselves in the crystal-clear waters, snorkel among the colorful marine life, or relax on the pristine sands, soaking up the sun.

## San Cristobal Island

### | Day Notes

The approved itinerary dictates that we either commence our journey with a visit to Kicker Rock, followed by the beach, or we reverse the order. The specific beach we head to—either Manglesito, Puerto Grande, or Cerro Brujo—depends on the boat's schedule.


Our first destination is typically Kicker Rock, a 45-minute journey from our starting point. Known as Leon Dormido in Spanish, this rock formation off the coast of San Cristobal Island in the Galapagos Islands resembles a sleeping lion. Rising 500 ft above the ocean, this small yet majestic island is a popular spot for various marine birds. Here, you'll have the opportunity to snorkel for an hour in the 35-meter-deep channel of Kicker Rock, which reduces to a depth of 12 meters as you progress. The marine life you can expect to encounter includes white-tip sharks, black-tip sharks, Galapagos sharks, eagle rays, turtles, and a variety of fish.

Next, we visit Manglesito Beach, which offers two distinct areas for exploration: the mangrove area and the beach itself. The former is perfect for spotting aquatic bird life, while the latter provides an ideal spot for relaxation or swimming. In the mangrove area, you'll come across a lagoon inhabited by animals such as patios, terms reales, and zarapitos, among other native species. The beach is adorned with vegetation like sesubium edmonstonei and button mangrove. After approximately 30 minutes of travel from Kicker Rock, we'll spend an hour at Manglesito Beach. Lunch will be served on the boat before you set out to explore the beach.

***Please note that each day brings different conditions; consequently, the animals that can be spotted may vary.***

## Puerto Villamil

### | Day Notes

Begin your day with a scenic 30-40-minute flight from San Cristobal to Isabela. Upon arrival, our representative will escort you to the hotel for breakfast.

First, we'll visit the Tortoise Breeding Center of Isabela, a sanctuary for 330 turtles. Here, you can observe these magnificent creatures in a protected environment.

Next, we'll explore Puerto Villamil's Flamingo Ponds, home to around 500 flamingos. After this fascinating encounter, we'll return to the hotel.

In the afternoon, we'll journey to the Wall of Tears. This 8 km route can be covered on foot or by bicycle, offering sightings of giant turtles and all four types of Galapagos mangroves at El Estero. A climb up Cerro Orchilla offers panoramic views of the island before we reach the historic Wall of Tears.



Today you are set to explore Sierra Negra, a beautiful encounter with nature that offers exquisite bird watching and stunning flora. Departing from your hotel, a short 30-minute drive brings you to the Galapagos National Park Control point, marking the start of your trekking journey. After an invigorating 45-minute hike, you reach your destination - the second viewpoint. Here, you marvel at the breathtaking caldera of Sierra Negra Volcano, reputed as the world's second-largest crater. Towering at an elevation of 1,220 meters and spanning 10 kilometers in diameter, this site is truly awe-inspiring. The landscape within this hollow boasts volcanic lava and lush vegetation, adding to its charm.

Inside this colossal hollow, you witness a striking contrast of volcanic lava against the verdant vegetation, making for an awe-inspiring sight. As we soak in the breathtaking views, we learn about this spectacular natural formation's geological significance and history.

Your primary activity for the day is an invigorating hike designed to engage beginners and seasoned hikers. The tour, including the walk, encapsulates 17 kilometers between round trip.

Embark on an enthralling half-day adventure to the pristine Tintoreras in the heart of Isabela Island, Galapagos. This tour promises an unforgettable blend of scenic beauty, captivating wildlife, and exhilarating activities that truly encapsulate the spirit of this unique region.

Your day begins with a convenient pick-up from your hotel or resort. From there, you'll be whisked away in a local typical vehicle "chiva" or bus to the dock, where you'll board a charming, sturdy boat designed for intimate exploration, ensuring unobstructed views of breathtaking landscapes and marine life.

Watch for playful sea lions and white tips sharks as the boat glides through the azure waters.

Upon reaching Tintoreras (20-minute sailing time), you'll be greeted by the sight of marine iguanas basking on the black lava rocks, pelicans perched on mangroves, and turtles lazily swimming around the clear, shallow waters. A guided hike through the island's lava fissures and flows offers a unique insight into the area's geological history.

One of the tour's highlights is the opportunity to snorkel in the crystal-clear waters surrounding the island. With the equipment provided, immerse yourself in an underwater world teeming with colorful fish and fascinating coral reefs.

This tour showcases the region's rich biodiversity and promotes sustainable tourism by educating visitors about the importance of preserving these unique ecosystems.

To ensure you make the most of your day, we recommend wearing comfortable walking shoes for the hike, and don't forget to bring your swimsuit for the snorkeling session. A hat, sunscreen, and a refillable water bottle are also must-haves.

Remember, the beauty of Tintoreras lies in its untouched nature. Adhere to the guidelines provided by your guide, respect the wildlife, and leave no trace behind.

## Puerto Ayora

### | Day Notes

Set sail on a magical morning journey from the enigmatic Isabela Island towards the lively and diverse Santa Cruz.

Submerge yourself in the vibrant core of Santa Cruz, the archipelago's most populous island. Its distinctive charm is captivating, a harmonious blend of untouched natural splendor and rich local culture. We'll traverse the glistening azure waters aboard a shared vessel, culminating with our arrival on the island, where a driver will be waiting for us to take us to the hotel and leave our luggage and time for breakfast.

Our first visit will be to the Charles Darwin Research Station. At the Tortoise Breeding Center, you'll get an up-close look at various tortoises native to the Galapagos Islands. This research station serves a critical mission: to use scientific research and other measures to ensure biodiversity conservation and the environment within the Galapagos Archipelago.

Our next stop is the intriguing Twins Craters, two pit craters formed by the collapse of empty magma chambers. Nestled amidst the lush vegetation of the high-elevation humid zone, these craters provide a stunning view of the *Scalesia* forest and its avian inhabitants.

Next, we venture into the Highlands and the Lava Tunnels of Santa Cruz. Here, you'll have the chance to see the renowned giant tortoises in their natural habitat. These prehistoric-looking creatures often extend their necks for a snack or a photo opportunity. The dense forest, home to orchids, daisies, and bromeliads, also houses several endemic land birds, including Darwin's finches, Galapagos Hawks, and short-eared owls. Amidst this natural splendor, enjoy a delicious lunch surrounded by nature.

### **Bartolome / Sullivan**

At around 6:00 am, we will head to the Itabaca Channel to embark on our day tour yacht, setting sail for Bartolome Island's pristine white-sand beaches and crystal-clear turquoise waters.

After two hours, we reach Bartolome, one of the youngest islands in the Galapagos archipelago, home to the iconic Pinnacle Rock. On the island, you can enjoy a brief, easy walk up a wooden path for stunning views of two picturesque bays, intriguing lava formations, and volcanic cones. Snorkel with adorable penguins, sea lions, sea

turtles, sharks, white tip reefs, tropical fish, and other unique marine life. We'll also visit Sullivan Bay to marvel at its incredible lava formations and colors.

We will return to Puerto Ayora around 5 pm, where you will be escorted to your hotel.

### **North Seymour Norte / Bachas Beach**

Around 7:00 am, we will depart by boat for North Seymour, a small island teeming with natural wonders. Here, you will find the largest population of magnificent Frigate birds, numerous blue-footed boobies, and swallow-tailed gulls.

Snorkeling allows you to encounter green sea turtles, the renowned Galapagos shark, playful sea lions, and other marine species.

### **Plazas Island / Carrion Point**

Leaving at approximately 7:00 am, you will be collected from your hotel and taken to the boat for a journey to the Plazas Islands.

Upon arrival, you will be greeted by the largest colonies of sea lions and numerous land iguanas. As you walk along the path to the other side of the island, you will discover marine iguanas and various bird species, including boobies, blue-footed and masked boobies, swallow-tailed gulls nesting puffins,, and tropical birds. Frigate birds and pelicans are also known to soar above the ravines.

### **Santa Fe Island**

This island boasts a stunning turquoise bay with two white sand beaches inhabited by sea lions. A rocky path leads to an hour-and-a-half hike, during which you can observe different species.

While snorkeling, you may encounter green sea turtles. Lunch will be served onboard, and you will be transported back to your hotel.
